

## Useful items to bring/send to Bwindi Community Hospital

In general, monetary donations are better for us than donated items. We can buy most of the things that we need in Kampala and it is always better to have a regular supplier rather than random items from overseas.

If people would prefer not to give money then there are some items that we would use:

### 1. Computing equipment:

- Laptop computers for staff to use – we have the Internet but staff members are limited as we only have 20 computers between 120 people. A new bottom of the range laptop would be best, but any old laptops that are functioning and have good battery life would be appreciated.
- 8 port Switches to branch Ethernet connections for wired network
- Access Points or routers to expand wireless network
- Optical Mice

### 2. Other useful non-medical items

- Rechargeable batteries AA or AAA
- Head torches
- Solar or wind-up hand torches (please no hand torches that require batteries)
- Printer cartridges (black & colour. MUST be HP 130, HP129, HP135, HP95 or HP98)
- HP deskjet printer
- Toys for children's ward
